At Aycliffe Village Primary School our swimming lessons are provided by staff from Durham County Council at Newton Aycliffe Leisure Centre.

Children begin swimming lessons in Year 3. During Year 3 and Year 4 children swim weekly for 1 term. In Year 5 and 6 the children swim for half a term each during the summer term.

We are now required to publish the following information regarding attainment in swimming:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations
