**Bags to School—PTA Fundraiser**

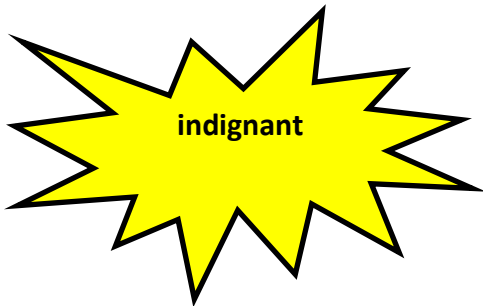
