Update for Key/Critical Workers—Child Care during the Easter Holidays

Dear parents/carers

I hope you are all keeping well and that pressures in your working roles are not too difficult, during these challenging times.

Thank you for liaising with us to keep us updated about your requirements for child care during the Easter holidays. I appreciate your work circumstances can be changeable, at this time. Thank you also to Mrs Brown and Mrs Swainston for collecting and co-ordinating all of this information so staff rotas can be confirmed. I know it hasn't always been easy as circumstances are constantly changing.

I wanted to let you know that there are some days when we don't have any families who need child care over Easter so our school will be closed. However, it is important you have a way of contacting us in case your work circumstances change unexpectedly and you have no other option for child care. You can do this, via email, on:

This email address will be checked daily. Please let us know as soon as possible and, by 6.00pm at the latest, if you unexpectedly need child care for the next day. This will then give us time to inform staff and to make necessary arrangements for the school to be open.

A reminder that children attending will need to bring packed lunches as we don't have provision for school meals over the holidays.

I am sure you would also like to join me in thanking all school staff who are helping provide child care during their holidays.
