I have recently joined the Aycliffe team.

In **English** this term, we will be focusing on the following:

Year 3/4 Spelling Rules - including prefixes: - sub, -super and words suffixes: -tion, ssion, sion, sure and ture, stories from other cultures and texts linked to our *Geography/History* topic.

Please bring reading records and reading books into school **daily**. Children can collect up to 5 signatures each week for our class reading chart by reading to an adult at home and having their reading record signed each time. If your child reads on more than 5 days, they will receive slips for extra signatures (up to 7 each week).

Geography - What is Italy like?

History - What was daily life like in Roman Britain?

In **Mathematics** this term, we will be focusing on the following:

Decimals - tenths and hundredths, Money & Measure - solving simple measure and money problems, Statistics - interpreting data and solving problems, Time - reading, writing and converting time between analogue and digital clocks and Multiplication - in particular, x7, x8, x9 and x12.

We will also have weekly **PSHE** lessons and that we have time for wellbeing/mindfulness activities each week.

Things to Remember:

PE will be taught on a Wednesday afternoon and a Friday morning - please ensure children come to school in an appropriate PE kit as we could be using the hall or we might be outside for PE.

Homework will be given out on a **Friday**. Please return homework books by the following **Tuesday**.
