Curriculum

Welcome to the Summer Term at Aycliffe Village Primary School. I am delighted to be working with your children this year.

The children in Year Six will have P.E. on a Monday and a Wednesday so will need to come to school wearing the appropriate kit. P.E. kit is white t-shirt, dark shorts, and plimsolls/trainers but children are also encouraged to wear hoodies and tracksuit bottoms/joggers when the weather is colder, and we have P.E. outside.

Your children have access to the school library area every day. They have already chosen their books to read and are welcome to change these as and when they need to. When reading at home, the children are also able to read their own books for pleasure! Reading is an important part of the curriculum and because of this I ask if all parents can ensure that their child brings their reading book and reading record into school every day. If you have read with your child, please remember to sign their reading record – all signatures will count towards our class reading challenge.

On Fridays, children will bring home their weekly homework. This will either be one Maths or English task and additional optional homework tasks will be included for those children who are interested. We ask that homework is completed and returned to school by the following Wednesday so that homework can be marked, and feedback can be given. Homework handed in later than Wednesday will be marked the following week.

Things to Remember:

PE Kit is needed on a Monday and a Wednesday.

Homework is to be returned on a Wednesday and new homework will be given each Friday.

Reading Records and reading books can be returned daily for books to be changed.
